

Freedom Farm Barn Rules

1. This is God's Property! No tobacco, alcohol, or fowl language anywhere on the premise. Only Christian music to be played.
2. Please no running, screaming or boisterous playing in the barn.
3. Children under the age of 13 are to be under adult supervision at all times and may not enter stalls or paddocks without an approved adult.
4. Be kind to everyone here and think of your horse and other's before yourself.
5. All riders and guests must sign a liability release before handling or riding any horse.
6. Approved riding helmets must be worn at all times while mounted if under 18 years of age.
7. All riders should be dressed appropriately for safe riding. Includes long pants and boots with a small heel. Please be considerate of others and dress modestly to protect yourself and our integrity.
8. Each person is responsible for cleaning up after themselves and their horses. Put trash in trash can.
9. Clean up manure immediately; do not wait until after you ride. Clean alley ways after each use.
10. No horses is to be left unattended while tied or in the cross ties.
11. Please make sure all tack, brushes, saddles etc are picked up and placed back in the respective area.
12. Any loss of equipment is not the responsibility of Freedom Farm. Do not use anyone else's equipment without permission.
13. Turn water hydrant off when not in use. Warm weather, keep hose out for ease of use, Cold weather, keep hose unhooked and carry water buckets.
14. Do not feed any horse but your own without owner's permission.
15. Do not allow your horse to "sniff noses" with other horses, as this can lead to injuries.
16. Please take reasonable care when turning out or riding your horse. Try not to tear up the footing.
17. Each person will implement any instructions or suggestions for safety made by our staff.
18. Please park on the gravel. Do not drive on soft ground, mud or grass.

Your cooperation to following these rules is greatly appreciated.
These rules are for your protection as well as your children and the horses.
