### **Below are the details for riding lessons:**

Horseback riding lessons are scheduled for approximately one hour sessions. Circumstances might require more time, including but not limited to cooling your horse off, rinsing or blanketing your horse.

We do lessons Monday through Friday from around 1 PM - 8 PM.

### **What's Involved**

- All students start by learning how to halter, lead and work with a horse from the ground. Then each lesson, the student will be performing every step in the process of riding. We teach horsemanship, not just riding.
- Students will groom, tack and care for the horse each lesson.
- It will be approximately the third or fourth lesson before they ride.
- Students will start western.
- We will memorize scripture as we also learn about horses.

### **Pricing**

- It's \$35 for a single lesson or \$240 for a package of 8 lessons (which makes each lesson \$30 and savings of \$40).
- Packages are scheduled for once a week on the same day and time for 8 consecutive weeks.
- Lessons are individual (one student per instructor).
- Lessons cannot be every other week unless you would like to pay for the weeks you are not here.
- A package of 8 lessons will not exceed a 12 week period of time. After 12 weeks, a new package must be bought in order to keep your lesson spot.
- ★ All lessons and packages are non-refundable and non-transferable ★

### **Barn Attire - All students are required to wear proper barn attire**

- Jeans - DO NOT wear stretch or sweat pants.
- Proper top - DO NOT wear spaghetti straps or tank tops or crop tops.
- Riding boots with a smooth sole and small heel (½ to 1 inch heel).
- Students under 18 are required to wear riding helmets (provided if needed).
- Appropriate accoutrements for the weather/season (layers, gloves, ear warmers, cooling towel, etc.).
- DO NOT wear revealing clothing. Please dress with modesty. Thank you in advance for protecting the integrity of Freedom Farm and its ministries!

### **Rules**

- Students under 18 are required to wear riding helmets (provided if needed).
- It will be approximately the third or fourth lesson before they ride.
- Students must listen to their trainer/instructor and follow their instructions at all times. Students not following instructions or acting in an unsafe or disrespectful manner will be asked to dismount or cease activity immediately. This rule is for your safety, the safety of other participants, and the horse's well-being. That lesson will be a charged lesson even if it is cut short because of the student's behavior.
- For safety reasons, anyone accompanying the student, must remain in the Viewing Area/Office and wear close toed shoes. The barn is not a spectator area. All persons in the barn will be regarded as participants and limited by the Inherent Risk Law.
- Ask before petting ANY of the horses or animals.
- DO NOT feed ANYTHING to the horses. This includes any hay or grass found on the ground. We appreciate your help in keeping our horses safe and healthy!

### **Cancellation**

- All cancellations require 24 hour notice, if not it will be a charged lesson.
- If 2 or more consecutive sessions are cancelled, a session will be charged (Instructor Cancellation Excluded).
- Continual absences, rescheduling, no shows or cancellations will result in the loss of your lesson spot and paid lessons will be charged.
- Once a student is scheduled for a lesson time spot, you have bought that time slot and it is reserved for you and you alone. An instructor has been hired to teach you, and your horse has been specifically assigned to you. Attendance is very important.
- Lessons will be cancelled when the real feel temperature in the barn is below 30 degrees or bad weather conditions, the instructor will determine that and notify you. That lesson will be added to the end of your package. During inclement weather do not assume that your lesson has been cancelled.
- Any lessons canceled by Freedom Farm will not be charged and will be rescheduled.
- If you plan on discontinuing or taking a break from lessons, you must give a 30 day advance notice to end your lessons and be removed from your lesson slot. That gives us plenty of time to fill your lesson spot. If a 30 day notice is not given, you will be billed for two lessons.
